BOARD POLICY DEVELOPMENT

### **Policy No. 110-P**

It is the policy of the Board of Education that the Board reserves itself that function of providing guides for the discretionary action of those to who it delegates authority. These guides for discretionary action constitute the policies governing the operation of the School District. They will be recorded in writing.

The formulation and adoption of these policies will constitute the basic method by which the Board exercises its leadership in the operation of the school system, the study, and evaluation of reports concerning the execution of its control over the operation of the school system.

Any policy in effect whether explicit in statement or arrived at by agreement and/or practice will remain in effect until superseded by a formally adopted policy.

The formal adoption of policies will be recorded in the minutes of the Board. Only those written statements so adopted and so recorded will be regarded as official Board Policy.
