Description: APPEAL PROCEDURES

Regulation: 304-R

The Board recognizes that students and/or parents may disagree with the decisions made by school district employees concerning the education, health or safety of students. Some areas of concern may include, but not be exclusive of, the assignment of students to classes or courses, grading practices, participation in or exclusion from school activities, or student discipline.

Students and/or parents who disagree with and wish to discuss the decisions are expected to see resolution in the following manner:

1. Teacher or Classroom Level Decision

- a) Discuss directly with the teacher;
- b) If not resolved, discuss with the Principal;
- c) If not resolved, discuss with the Superintendent;
- d) Unresolved matters may be referred to the Board through a Trustee.

2. Administrator or School Level Decision

- a) Discuss directly with the Administrator;
- b) if not resolved, discuss with the Superintendent;
- c) Unresolved matters may be referred to the Board through a Trustee.

3. District Level Decision

- a) Discuss directly with the Superintendent;
- b) Unresolved matters may be referred to the Board through a Trustee.

4. Board Level Decision

Appeals referred to the Board for a decision are subject to the conditions of the Appeals Bylaw No. 3 and shall be initiated by the completion of the 'Notice of Appeal' form referred to as (Appendix A) in the Bylaw.
