ACCIDENTS AT SCHOOL

Policy No. 305-P

All staff, both teaching and non-teaching, should be consistent and thorough in their attention to grounds, buildings, and equipment to ensure that unsafe conditions do not exist. Unsafe conditions are to be given first priority by the Maintenance Department.

Principals and teachers shall see that pupils in the school and on the grounds are adequately supervised while under school authority.

The Board of Education will ensure provision of first aid equipment in all schools. In the case of an accident or any emergency affecting any pupil in the school the Principal shall deal with the matter using his/her own good judgement. Normally the responsibility of the Board is restricted to treatment in accordance with proper first aid measures.

An accident report form shall be submitted to the Secretary Treasurer within 48 hours of the accident. Standard report forms are available from the District Office and should be on file in each school.
