ADMINISTERING MEDICINES TO STUDENTS

### **Policy No. 306-P**

It is the policy of the Board of Education EXCEPT IN EMERGENCY SITUATIONS, that teachers should administer (or supervise the self-administering of) medicine to pupils only if the following conditions are met:

1. The medication is required while the child is attending school.
2. A parent has requested that the school's assistance and has signed a release concerning administration by the teacher.
3. Written authorization has been received from an attending physician.
4. The Public Health Nurse has been informed so that she may complete a Medic Alert Card.
5. The teacher has received adequate instructions from the Public Health Nurse concerning the administration of the medication.
