PROTECTION OF PUPILS AND MAINTENANCE OF ORDER

Policy No. 307-P

The Board of Education authorizes Principals, Vice-Principals, teachers, custodians, maintenance workers, and building supervisors in its employ to make such directions and to follow such courses of action as are deemed appropriate for the protection of children and the maintenance of order when school is in session and or at any official school function.

The Board declares that this resolution constitutes an authorization pursuant to Section 191 of the School Act.

The order of authority under this authorization is as follows:

1. Principal, and in the event of his absence, a
2. Vice-Principal, and in the event of his absence,
3. Teacher, and in the event of his absence, a
4. Janitor, and in the event his his/their absence,
5. Maintenance Worker, and in the event of his/their absence,
6. Building Supervisor

The Board further authorizes a person not employed by the Board to whom responsibility for the care of the building(s) has been assigned during authorized community use of the buildings(s) to make such directions and to follow such courses of action as are deemed appropriate for the protection of children and maintenance of order.
