Preamble

The Board recognizes the artistic talents and creativity of the District's students and staff.

Policy

The Board encourages the use of walls of schools to display murals done by the District's students and staff, within the parameters of the procedures provided.

Procedures to be followed when a class or a school proposes to paint, alter, or replace a mural on a schoolroom wall:

- 1. The proposal, including associated costs, must be submitted to the school principal.
- 2. The Principal and Director of Operations shall agree on location and material applications in advance of presenting the proposal to the Board.
- 3. The project must have Board approval before proceeding.
- 4. The Maintenance Department must be engaged in the procedure to ensure adherence to policies and procedures as it relates to WCB and building code regulations and to:
 - Ensure appropriate and compatibility of paint used.
 - Obtain best possible price.
