- February 1<sup>st</sup> NESS Principal had organized, as a fresh start for the school, a cleansing of the school, windows were opened, they smudged through the school. Elders went through with drums to drive out evil spirits. There was a welcoming fresh......and a fresh start. There were cedar boughs around the school. In the gymnasium there was a blanketing ceremony, which involved elders of the community who came in, and as well key representatives. There was a recognition of the passing of responsibility from the community to the leaders of the education system to take on the mantel of educating the young people.
- Student Learning at Alvin A. McKay Elementary School students getting outside, but also the incorporation of art and form to what they were doing.
