HARASSMENT/SEXUAL HARASSMENT, BULLYING AND INTIMIDATION

Policy No. 320-P

The Board of Education recognizes that students, employees, volunteers, sponsors and parents have the right to a positive, safe and secure environment free from harassment, bullying and intimidation and accepts that it has a duty to promote tolerance and respect for the rights of all who attend its schools.

Harassment is defined as repeated, objectionable conduct or comment, directed toward a specific person or persons which has the effect of creating an intimidating, humiliating, hostile or offensive learning or working environment. Harassment does not include conduct or comments made in good faith to exercise the rights, duties and responsibilities of those participating in the school environment.
