This is the detailed instructions on what to do to reconnect the computers back to the default district network (SD92 District):

- 1. Connect the computer to a temporary network:
 - 1. Connect to SD92 Guest
 - 2. Connect to the network physically using an ethernet cable connected to a port.
- 2. Once the computer is successfully connected to a temporary network, go to System Preferences



3. In the System Preferences, click on Network.



4. Once on Network, make sure you are on the Wi-Fi. If you are already connected to a temporary network (refer to Step 1), click on the Connect button next to "802.1x: WiFi (SD92 District)".
