

Minor Incident Report

Date of Incident: Friday, October 31, 2025

Time: 7:35am

Location: Bottom of the hill east of Black Point

Description of Incident

The districts school bus that carries students from Gingolx to NESS was parked on the side of the road to allow an oversized trailer to pass safely, the trailer contacted the bus, causing minor damage. The bus was not in motion at the time of the incident, and no students were injured.

After contact both the bus driver and driver of the wide load transport vehicle had met and looked at the area of contact. Determined that it was a minor incident and opted to carry on to their respective destinations.

The bus driver then communicated, upon arrival to the maintenance yard, an overview of what occurred to his supervisor. Later that day had met with the RCMP that came to do a follow up.

At the time of writing this report no further communication has been undertaken with either the RCMP or the Company

Immediate Actions Taken:

- At the time of the incident the bus driver ensured all safety measures were maintained and confirmed there were no injuries

Extent of Damage:

Minor exterior damage to the bus the left rear bumper (as per attached photo)

Follow-up:

- A follow-up debriefing with the bus driver will be undertaken to emphasise the need to more timely communication
- Tail gate meeting with all bus drivers to discuss the situation since there is the potential for more wide load transport vehicles utilizing the Nisga'a Highway.
